




Our technology enabled care is there to support you no matter where you call home. Our portable solutions are designed to care anywhere, for anyone and any time.

Whoever you are, whatever challenge you have, we are here to Cair for you all.




Design for All...

Notifier

Portable Alarm Receiver

The Notifier is a clever device which helps you care. It connects wirelessly to our full range of smart devices which can let you know when your loved one or person you support needs help. Whether they have got out of bed, left the house in the early hours of the morning, have experienced a flood or need to let you know they have fallen, this compact intelligent pager will allow you to care even better.



The Notifier can be used from one-to-one scenarios all the way through to care home settings, linking with up to 150 devices. The carer will receive direct alerts on the Notifier, informing them exactly where the alert is coming from, enabling a prompt and targeted response.

Our most advanced system yet, it can even be programmed to divert to another Notifier or a dispersed unit in the event that a carer is unable to respond to a call.

The intuitive programming menus allow users to configure the Notifier with little or no training required. All paired devices and settings can easily be cloned from one Notifier to another. Advanced settings are accessible only by PIN to protect against unauthorised tampering.

The SOS feature means that formal and informal carers have means to call for help themselves too, with a clear and easy to access button to raise an alarm.

Where sensors are programmed to alert several Notifiers, our new auto-clear feature allows all other Notifiers to automatically clear the call when a carer has acknowledged the alert on another device.

The Notifier charges wirelessly when dropped into the base, with up to 3 days battery life from one charge.



The waterproof Onyx is available as a neck or wrist worn pendant. The neck cord is available in a soft black fabric or steel chain.





It is ideal to use in bathrooms, kitchens or any flood prone areas to warn of unattended taps being left running, or blocked sinks or toilets. No fixture or fitting is required. It should simply be placed on a flat surface close to a bath, wash basin, toilet, or wherever a flood or leak is likely to occur. The Flood can also be mounted with water resistant adhesive pads.

Programming is easy, and a damp cloth is all you need to activate it.





The gold plated contacts are fractionally raised above the floor to avoid false alarms.

The Flood boasts 600m line of sight range and a 5 year replaceable battery life.

The simple but smart Cair Detect allows monitoring of bed/chair occupancy and enuresis, all in one unit. Designed with ease of use in mind, the Detect can provide visual and audible indication for additional reassurance to both users and carers.

It is jam-packed with features including 'cancel at source' and 'virtual sensor' compatibility. The Detect also has absence time options built-in, ranging from 0.5 seconds to 30 minutes.



Installer friendly, the Detect can be easily configured using a simple to use rotary dial. Two RJ12 terminal inputs are provided for multiple device connections, allowing you to monitor more with just one device.



The Detect also boasts a 600m line of sight range and a 3 year replaceable battery life. The Detect can be used to monitor chair or bed occupancy. Use it with our Sit/Sleep bed and chair pads for the best results.



The moisture sensing mat sits underneath a cotton top sheet or on top of any protective sheet. These durable and wipe-clean sensor mats can be re-used for cost effective and hygienic implementation. When plugged into the Cair Detect, it can send an alert upon detection of excess moisture. The Enuresis mat is also interoperable with most telecare systems.




Floor

Connect, it will alert immediately when a user stands on it.







The Smoke+ and Heat+ alarms are intelligent, discreet, compact interlinked units. They can be easily programmed to interlink with each other, ensuring all connected devices alert when needed. This means that a Smoke+ in the bedroom will also alert if the Heat+ in the kitchen is activated, providing even more reassurance and a safer environment.



Interlinking a group of Smoke+ and Heat+ alarms is easy to do using internal buttons on the devices. Easy to install, the devices will automatically switch on when the devices are secured to their mounting base. A safety lock prevents easy removal.




With two easy methods to pair and unpair devices within a group, programming is straightforward and simple. As well as having a group of interlinked devices, the alarms can also be connected to our Notifier pager or compatible dispersed units.

The devices include an extra-large test button and a silence button for alarms and low battery.

The Smoke+ provides the earliest warning of a developing fire whilst being highly resistant to nuisance alarms. The Heat+ is specifically designed for applications where smoke alarms would be unsuitable, such as kitchens, garages and dusty areas.







Pill Medication Dispenser

The Pivotell Advance automatic pill dispenser allows medication to be dispensed safely and securely at the time it is needed. When the medication is ready to be taken, the device will rotate to release the medication and alert the user. The medication can then be tipped from the device.



With 28 medication compartments, the Pill can store medication for almost a month, depending on the frequency of the medication taken.

With an LCD display along with audible and visual indication, the Pill is user friendly.










The two AA batteries are easily changed by removing just one small screw.

The Vibe is a discreet, attractive, all in one DDA device.



The Vibe can be be configured to suit the individual, with the ability to combine strobe, audible and voice alerts. Connected to the mains power, with a 24-hour back-up battery, the user can be reassured that the Vibe is always on.

The Vibe will alert the user of an environmental sensor activation, and can also support carers with sensory impairments, so that they can be notified when a telecare sensor has been activated. The large, easy to press button means it's simple to acknowledge the alarm.




